All Horses with the exception of Classes 4 to 8 inclusive, MUST be registered on the SHB (GB) Basic Identity Register

The Judges decision is Final

In the interest of safety all stallions born before 01/01/2009 must identify themselves by the handler wearing a Yellow armband supplied by themselves.

BREEDERS PRIZE 2010

In an attempt to acknowledge our breeders, SHB in the N.W. are looking for THE outstanding horse of 2010.

The horse must be bred in the North West and excelled in its own field during 2009, be it Point to Point, Racing, Show jumping, Dressage, Eventing, Driving, Showing (In Hand or Ridden), or Long Distance, during the period 30th November 2009 – 31st October 2010.

If you have or know someone who has a horse fulfilling these criteria, send the details to the secretary Mrs. Kath Smith.

The committee will select from the nominations received and the award will be presented at the AGM and Luncheon in December 2010 to the breeder of this horse.

Please note, the breeder must be a member of the Society this year, not necessarily at the time of breeding.

The horse must have been bred in the Northwest but not necessarily be owned by a North West Member, or currently reside in the North West.

Class 3.

Six Year Old.

Open to any six year old that exceeds 148cms(14.2hh approx.).

RULES

- Any Rider can present up to three horses in each class.
- The horses will come into the ring individually and will give a short ridden display of walk, trot and canter, worth up to **20 marks**.
- They will then proceed straight into the jumping round. The first fence may be jumped as a practice fence. Each jumping effort will be marked out of 10 at the judge's discretion. There is no penalty for a pole down or a run out. However, three refusals or a fall of horse or rider will result in elimination.
- The jumping course will be a mixture of coloured and rustic obstacles and will be designed to produce eight jumping efforts in total. (**80 marks**).
- All horses, unless eliminated, will be required to come back without saddles, for conformation assessment out of a possible **50 marks**.
- Boots are not allowed.

Please bring proof of horse's age (i.e. passport, vaccination certificate or registration document), as random checks will be made.

All Exhibits must be registered with the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB). Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form. Horses will be ridden by the Judge.

This Show is a qualifier for the BLUE CHIP & IDHS (GB) £2000 CHALLENGE. The highest placed horse (not already qualified) from Class 7 and 8 will qualify for the Final of the Blue Chip Championship, which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Annual Breed Show in September 2010. Each qualifier will receive a rosette and £10 voucher from Blue Chip. In THE FINAL, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money and a Blue Chip rug, the Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, £100 prize money plus a Trophy will be awarded to the highest placed Pure Bred and a Trophy and £50 to the highest placed Under 15.2hh.

CLASS 9

Open Working Hunter

HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW (HOYS) QUALIFYING CLASS

Class 9 is a qualifying event for the current year HOYS and only horses registered on the Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter/ Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and owners and riders must be members of the society. No horse lower than THIRD in its Class will qualify

OPEN WORKING HUNTER Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and upward. For horses exceeding 148cm (approx 14.2hh) Grade A showjumpers & Advanced Eventers are not eligible to compete. To be judged 60% for jumping performance, 40% as for Hunter Classes. The Jumping to be judged 40% for actual jumping and 20% for style and presence whilst jumping. 40% to be split between ride and conformation. There will be between eight and twelve fences with a maximum height of 1.14m (approx 3ft 9ins). Both the number and height will be at the discretion of the judge. The manner of going to be taken into account. No change of rider or tack will be allowed. Boots are NOT allowed.

No hind boots or bandages of any description are allowed in the collection ring, warm up or in the actual class

Fences will be a minimum height of 0.85m (2ft 9ins) and a maximum height of 1.00m (3ft 3ins)

Maximum height of fences 1.07m (3ft 6ins)

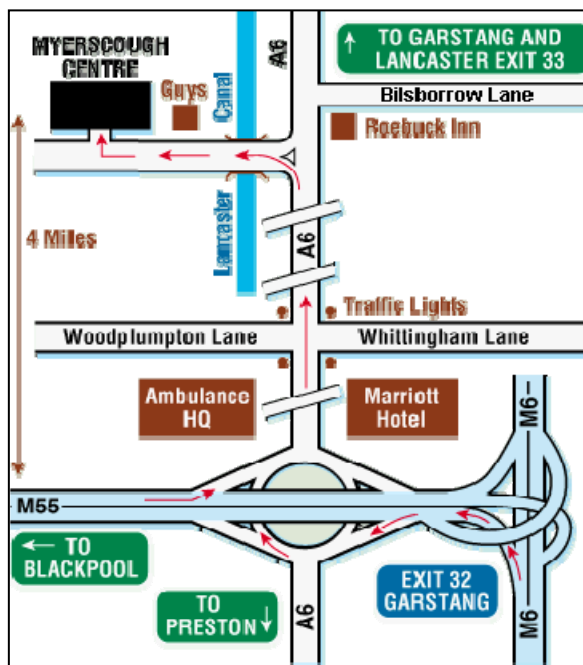

Myerscough College is 6 miles north of Preston, off the A6 Preston to Lancaster road.

Travelling by road from the South: Leave the M6 at Junction 32 (Broughton, Preston), the junction incorporates the M6 and M55 motorways and the A6 trunk road. Care should be taken to filter left following the 'A6 Garstang' lane indicators. On joining the A6, follow the 'Garstang' signs for 3¾ miles to a large sign on the left hand side of the road naming 'Myerscough College', and turn left along St Michaels Road. The College is ¾ mile along this road and involves a right turn half way through an S bend. Follow signs to Equine Arena.

Travelling by road from the North: Leave the M6 at Junction 33 (Hampson Green). On joining the A6 travel south following 'Preston' signs for about 9 miles to a large sign on the left hand side of the road, naming 'Myerscough College', and turn right into St Michaels Road. The college is ¾ miles along this road and involves a right turn half way through an S bend. Follow signs to Equine Arena

Buses between Preston and Garstang or Lancaster, travel along the A6. The nearest bus stop to St Michaels Road is the Roebuck Inn.
