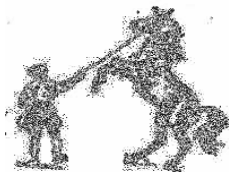

General Show Rules

A strict dress code as per SHB (GB) rules will be adhered to.

Registration / Identification numbers to be stated on the entry form.

Less than TEN ENTRIES prize money will only be awarded to 3rd place.

Less than SIX Entries prize money will only be awarded to 1st place unless otherwise stated

All trophies to be held for one year.

In the interest of safety all stallions born before 01/01/2007 must identify themselves by the handler wearing a Yellow armband supplied by themselves.

All horses except those in classes 15 & 16 must be on the SHG(GB) Basic Identity Register.

Late Entries will be accepted before the class commences at Double the Entry Fee except Classes 15, 16 and 20.

All cheques to be made payable to SHB (GB) North West

The Judges decision is Final.

In Hand Hunter Championship Trophy will be selected from the two 1st prizewinners from each age group in the In Hand Hunter Classes and will be judged immediately after Class 8.

The In Hand Sport Horse Class Trophies will be selected from the two 1st prizewinners from each age group at the time of the In Hand Sport Horse Championship, which will be judged immediately after Class 14A.

The Kirin Emsley Harris Trophy for pure and part bred Irish Draughts will be judged immediately after the In Hand Hunter Championship, by Mrs. J. Phillipps. Any horses entered in classes 1-14A will be eligible for this class but must be registered with or eligible for pure or part bred registration with the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB).

Lancashire and Cumbria H.I.S Trophy will be presented to the highest placed 3 y.o. Filly by a Thoroughbred Stallion from either In Hand sections.

A special rosette will be presented to the highest placed mare in all ridden classes by SHB in the North West.

The Irish Draught Horse Society of Great Britain will award special rosettes to the highest placed pure or partbred exhibit entered in classes 1 to 8. All exhibits must be registered or identified with IDHS(GB) on either their purebred or sporthorse register

All other boots and martingale are optional, but no boots to be worn for Sections III. Jumping whip only allowed (max length 75cm)

4. DRESS: As for British Eventing, Novice Dressage Test/ Hunting Dress. British Eventing /BHS approved hat and harness to be worn.
5. OPENING DATE: 14th MAY, 2008
6. CLOSING DATE: 14th JUNE, 2008.
7. In the event of over subscription this class may be closed early.
Balloting: In the event of over subscription entries received for horses that have already qualified for the Final will be balloted first.

Marks will not be awarded for individual movements but the test will be marked for general impression and overall performance.

C	Circle left 20 metres
HXF	Change rein. Show some lengthened strides (Not required for 4 year olds)
Between A & K	Canter right
E	Circle right 20 metres
MXK	Change rein At X Working trot

M	Working trot
H	Medium walk
E	Halt. Salute
EA	Free walk on a long rein and leave Arena

SECTION II

Jumping 40 Marks

No time will be allowed between these sections for any adjustments to tack or rider's dress.

Maximum height of fences 0.9m (4 year olds) 1.05m (5 year olds)

N.B, Fence height at Final 1.00m (4 year olds), 1.10m (5 year olds)

SECTION III

Conformation & type 15 Marks

N.B. following Section III the ten horses with the highest marks will proceed to Section IV.

In the event of equality of marks at this stage, the horse with the highest jumping mark will be given precedence.

Should this still produce an equality of marks, all horses on that same jumping mark will come forward

SECTION IV

Suitability and Potential 1-10 marks

Only the top ten horses are required for this Section, where they will be judged for star quality and potential to make the **ULTIMATE 3 DAY EVENT HORSE**. These horses will be required to gallop.

N.B. In the event of equality of marks at the end i.e. after all four Sections, the jumping mark will be given precedence. Should this still produce an equality of marks, the highest mark attained in the final section will be the deciding factor.

Open to any six year old that exceeds 148cms (14.2hh approx).

Maximum Height of fences 110cms (3'6")

RULES

- Any Rider can present up to three horses in each class.
- The horses will come into the ring individually and will give a short ridden display of walk, trot and canter, worth up to 20 marks.
- They will then proceed straight into the jumping round. The first fence may be jumped as a practice fence. Each jumping effort will be marked out of 10 at the judge's discretion. There is no penalty for a pole down or a run out. Three refusals however, will result in elimination.
- The jumping course will be a mixture of coloured and rustic obstacles and will be designed to produce eight jumping efforts in total. (80 marks).
- All horses, unless eliminated will be required to come back without saddles, for conformation assessment out of a possible 50 marks.
- Boots of a plain colour may be worn for the ridden and jumping phase
- Please bring proof of horses age (i.e. prevac-t certificate or registration document), as random checks will be made.

Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms (14.2hh approx).

Any horse which has qualified as a Grade A showjumper or Advanced Event horse as at the 1st Jan in the current year is not eligible to compete in Working Hunter Classes

All entries must be registered on the Basic Identity Register and the 2008 S.H.B/ Show Register. Owners & riders must be members of the S.H.B. (GB) and registration number quoted on the entry form.

Exhibitors may enter up to two horses but following the jumping phase it is up to the exhibitor to select **Only One** to go forward into the ridden and conformation section if required.

To be judged **60%** for jumping (that is **40%** actual jumping performance and **20%** style and presence). Ride and Conformation **40%**.

There will be a least 8 rustic fences. Size of fence up to 1.14m

No change of rider or tack will be allowed (unless a horse is ridden under side-saddle).

A skullcap or hardhat with safety harness, kite marked EN1384 and PAS 015 must be worn by all competitors during the jumping phase.

Skullcaps must have navy or black covers.

Plain coloured boots are permissible during the jumping phase only.

Rigid or weighted hind boots are not allowed.

Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms (14.2hh approx) not having won a total of £200 in prize money in any Working Hunter Class, or more than 25 BE eventing points or £200 BJSA Showjumping at home or equivalent abroad before January 1st 2008. This class will be judged under SHB (GB) rules. All entries must be registered on the SHB(GB) Basic Identity Register

Exhibitors may enter up to two horses but following the jumping phase it is up to the exhibitor to select **Only One** to go forward into the ridden and conformation section if required.

To be judged **60%** for jumping (that is **40%** actual jumping performance and **20%** style and presence). Ride and Conformation **40%**. There will be at least 8 rustic fences. Height of fences will not exceed 3'6" 1m.7cm No change of rider or tack will be allowed (unless a horse is ridden under side-saddle).

A skullcap or hardhat with safety harness, kite marked EN1384 and PAS 015 must be worn by all competitors during the jumping phase. Skullcaps must have navy or black covers.
