Registration / Identification numbers to be stated on the entry form.

Less than TEN ENTRIES prize money will only be awarded to 3rd. place.

Less than SIX Entries prize money will only be awarded to 1st. place unless otherwise stated

All trophies to be held for one year.

In the interest of safety all stallions born before 01/01/2009 must identify themselves by the handler wearing a Yellow armband supplied by themselves.

All horses except those in classes 1, 2 and 26 to 31 inclusive must be on the SHB (GB) Basic Identity Register.

Late Entries will be accepted before the class commences at Double the Entry Fee except Classes 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 26, 27 and 32.

All cheques to be made payable to SHB (GB) North West

The Judges decision is Final.

The Kirin Emsley Harris Trophy for pure and part bred Irish Draughts will be awarded to the winner of class 17. Any horses entered in classes 9-16 & 18-25 will be eligible for this class but must be registered with or eligible for pure or part bred registration with the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB).

Lancashire and Cumbria H.I.S Trophy will be presented to the highest placed 3 y.o. Filly by a Thoroughbred Stallion from either In Hand sections.

A special rosette will be presented to the highest placed mare in all ridden classes by SHB in the North West.

The Irish Draught Horse Society of Great Britain will award special rosettes to the highest placed pure or partbred exhibit entered in classes 9 to 16. All exhibits must be registered or identified with IDHS (GB) on either their purebred or sporthorse register

THE EQUIMAX/ERAQUELL COB OF THE YEAR QUALIFIER

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all owners, exhibitors and riders must be Association members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older

Classes 1 & 2 are qualifiers for **HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW**. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward and so forth to fifth place. In accordance with the BSHA rules the annual BSHA HOYS fee of £15 must have been paid to BSHA **before** the entry is made if the exhibitor wishes to qualify. The BSHA HOYS fee cannot be paid retrospectively. This fee is not the HOYS levy, which goes to Grandstand Media Ltd.

The three highest placed prize winners in all **open** affiliated classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic Supreme Classes at the National Championship Show on September 10th & 11th 2010.

The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each open class and a Championship rosette for each section. The highest placed Amateur Home Produced exhibit in all Horse of the Year Show qualifying classes will receive a Blue Chip rosette and £5 money-off voucher. The highest placed amateur will need to contact Sarah Butler by email sarah@bluechipfeed.com or on 0114 266 6200 (a maximum of 1 rosette to be won at a RIHS qualifier and 1 rosette at a HOYS qualifier per horse The award will then pass down the line) **Vibac Animal Health**, manufacturers of leading wormer brands Equimax and Eraquell, will issue the HOYS Cob qualifier in each class a qualification rosette and card, this will not be presented in the ring but will be forwarded along with conformation of qualification from BSHA

SECTION II Jumping 40 Marks

NO time will be allowed between these sections for any adjustments to tack or rider's dress.

Maximum height of fences 0.90m (4 year olds) 1.05m (5 year olds)

Note: Fence height at Final 1.00m (4 year olds), 1.10m (5 year olds)

SECTION III Conformation & type 15 Marks

Note: following Section III the ten horses with the highest marks will proceed to Section IV. In the event of equality of marks at this stage, the horse with the highest jumping mark will be given precedence. Should this still produce an equality of marks, all horses on that same jumping mark will come forward

SECTION IV Suitability and Potential 1-10 marks

*Only the top ten horses are required for this Section, where they will be judged for star quality and potential to make the **ULTIMATE THREE DAY EVENT HORSE**. These horses will be required to gallop.*

Note: In the event of equality of marks at the end i.e. after all four sections, the jumping mark will be given precedence. Should this still produce an equality of marks, the highest mark attained in the final section will be the deciding factor.

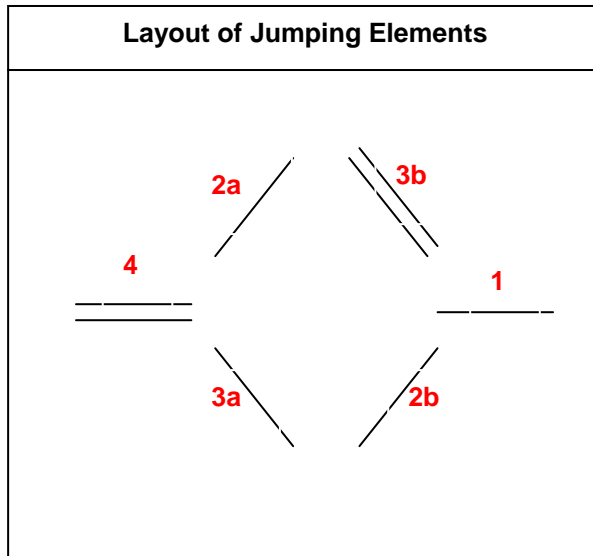
